

The Clermont Town Council met on April 2, 2013 Sonny Helton led the invocation. Mayor Nix led the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Mayor, James Nix, Council members, Sonny Helton, John Brady, and Ellen Rogers. Deputy Clerk, Amy Lomax, and Town Clerk, Sandra Helton.

DON CARTER STATE PARK- WILL WAGNER: Will Wagner greeted the Mayor and Council and told them he was going to be the park manager at the new Don Carter State Park located on North Browning Bridge Road off Clarks Bridge Road. He said he wanted to make them aware of the new state park which will be opening in approximately 6-8 weeks. The park will be hiring some full time and part time employees. The opening date will be on the state parks website in a couple of weeks. The park will have boat ramps, beach area for swimming, picnic shelters, playgrounds, cabins, bath houses with showers, paved biking trails, nature trails, and camp sites. The admission will be the same as other state parks which is \$5.00 for a gate pass for each vehicle.

CLERMONT DAYS CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION: John said things were progressing and the committee has already started with the task assigned. He mentioned he had the fireworks proposal. The Flag contest has ended and the 5 winners have been announced. The flag will be displayed at the opening ceremony for Clermont Days.
