

The Clermont Town Council met on March 6, 2012. Ellen Rogers led the invocation and Mayor Nix led the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Mayor, James Nix, Council members, Debra Armour, Seth Weaver, John Brady, and Ellen Rogers. Deputy Clerk, Amy Lomax.

MINUTES: Seth Weaver made a motion to accept the January 2012 Minutes. Debra Armour seconded, and all Council members voted in favor. Motion passed.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: Seth Weaver made a motion to accept the January 2012 Financial Statement. John Brady seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

REPORT: ORDINANCE 97-01 PLANNING AND ZONING: The Council reviewed this report.

ADA SIDEWALK BID: Mayor Nix said that we had received one bid regarding the ADA sidewalk project. The bid was turned in by Southern Pipeline. Mayor Nix opened the bid. The amount was for \$13,659.00. Seth Weaver made a motion to accept the bid. Debbie Armour seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

NEW BUSINESS:

FUNDRAISER FOR NORTH HALL JR TROJANS FOOTBALL TEAM: Dean Wilson asked the Mayor and Council if they could use the parking lot at the gym to hold a car show for a fundraiser. They would need it for the entire day and the date of the event would be August 5, 2012. The Mayor and Council agreed to let them use the parking lot.

NEW DESK: The Mayor and Council thanked John Brady for designing and building the new desk for the meeting room.

STREETS IN MEADOWS SUBDIVISION: John Brady asked if Tommy Rogers, Maintenance Supervisor had yet spoken with anyone about the bare spots in the asphalt on Oak Street in the Meadows Subdivision. The Mayor replied that he had met with the paving contractor and they are going to make the repairs. He also said he was planning on talking with Stan Brown from the city of Oakwood about some similar issues to see when the repairs will be made.

HANDLING FEE FOR VENDOR APPLICATIONS: John Brady asked the Mayor and Council if a \$5.00 fee could be added to all applicants for the Clermont Days vendors. The added amount will be distributed among the volunteers to compensate for their expenses. The Mayor and Council agreed to increase the vendor applications by \$5.00.
