

The Clermont Town Council met on May 1, 2012. Ellen Rogers led the invocation and Mayor Nix led the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Mayor, James Nix, Council members, Debra Armour, Seth Weaver, John Brady, Sonny Helton, and Ellen Rogers. Deputy Clerk, Amy Lomax, and Town Clerk, Sandra Helton.

MINUTES: Seth Weaver made a motion to accept the April 2012 Minutes. Sonny Helton seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: Seth Weaver made a motion to accept the April 2012 Financial Statement. John Brady seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

GEORGIA EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT-2012 STATEWIDE MUTUAL AID

AGREEMENT: The purpose of this agreement is to provide for mutual assistance between the Participating Parties in managing any emergency or disaster that is duly declared by the governing authority of any political subdivision that is a Participating Party, whether arising from natural disaster, technological hazard, human caused disaster, civil emergency aspects of resource shortages, community disorders, insurgency, enemy attack, acts of terrorism, other significant events or a national security activity. Captain Scott Cagle from the Hall County Fire Department made a brief presentation explaining the agreement. Seth Weaver made a motion to accept the agreement. Debbie Armour seconded, and all Council members voted in favor. Motion passed.

FIREPROOF FILE CABINET: Mayor Nix explained that the Town of Clermont needs another fireproof file cabinet because we have run out of space for important documents to be protected. Sonny Helton made a motion to purchase a used Fire King fireproof file cabinet for \$894.95 from Office Pro's. John Brady seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

PLAYGROUND IMPROVEMENTS: After much discussion and review by the Mayor and Council, Seth Weaver made a motion to have a special called meeting to vote on a bid package for the pavilion and deck only. Sonny Helton seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

CLERK TIME: Town Clerk Sandra Helton asked the Mayor and Council to review the ad for bids on the two propane tanks. After reviewing the ad everyone agreed the ad would run for three days in the legal organ and bids would be opened at the Special called meeting on May 8, 2012.

ADJOURN: Seth Weaver made a motion to adjourn at 8:28pm. Sonny Helton seconded, and all council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.
