

The Clermont Town Council met on June 4, 2012. Sonny Helton led the invocation and Mayor Nix led the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Mayor, James Nix, Council members, Debra Armour, Seth Weaver, John Brady, Sonny Helton, and Ellen Rogers. Deputy Clerk, Amy Lomax, and Town Clerk, Sandra Helton.

PUBLIC HEARING FOR 2012-2013 BUDGET: The budget is being set for \$250,530.00. Mayor Nix opened the public hearing at 7:01pm and opened the floor for comments. Hearing no comments, the Mayor said the public hearing would remain open for twenty minutes

MINUTES: Seth Weaver made a motion to accept the April 2012 Minutes. Debbie Armour seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

MINUTES FROM SPECIAL CALLED MEETING: Seth Weaver made a motion to accept the minutes from the May 8th Special called meeting. Sonny Helton seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: Seth Weaver made a motion to accept the April 2012 Financial Statement. John Brady seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

REPORT: ORDINANCE 97-01 REPORT: The Council reviewed the report.

PAVILLION BIDS: Mayor Nix opened the two bids that were submitted for the construction of the new pavilion on Market Street. Parks Livestock & Fencing submitted a bid for \$18,682.00 and Callaway Builders submitted a bid for \$23,559.00. Seth Weaver made a motion to award the bid to Parks Livestock & Fencing for \$18,682.00. Debbie Armour seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

CLOSE PUBLIC HEARING FOR 2012-2013 BUDGET: The Mayor asked if there were any questions or comments on the budget. After no further questions or comments on the budget, Mayor Nix closed the public hearing.

ADOPT 2012-2013 BUDGET: Seth Weaver made a motion to accept the 2012-2013 Budget of \$250,530.00. Sonny Helton seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

CLERK TIME: Town Clerk, Sandra Helton asked the Mayor and Council if the idea of moving the Town Hall into the Sheriff's Precinct building was still being considered. Mayor Nix said due to several things going on at this time and financial concerns we would have to wait.

COUNCIL MEMBER TIME: Seth Weaver said he had spoke with Benny Adams and wanted to know if the Mayor and Council would mind if he installed a fence on the property line near the creek to graze horses and cattle. The Mayor and Council discussed the situation and agreed not to at this time.

John Brady said he would like to recommend to the Council to relocate the recycle trailer to the maintenance shop. The Mayor and Council agreed to move the recycle trailer to the maintenance shop area on Oxford Street.

ADJOURN: Seth Weaver made a motion to adjourn at 7:47pm. Sonny Helton seconded, and all council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.
