

The Clermont Town Council met on August 5, 2014. The Mayor called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Seth Weaver gave the invocation and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Present: Mayor, James Nix, Council members, Seth Weaver, Lynn Adams, and John Brady. Deputy Clerk, and Town Clerk, Sandra Helton.

MINUTES: Seth Weaver made a motion to approve the July 2014 Minutes. John Brady seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: Seth Weaver made a motion to accept the July 2014 Financial Statement. Lynn Adams seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

REPORT: ORDINANCE 97-01 PLANNING AND ZONING: The council reviewed this report.

SECOND READING: SPECIAL ELECTION ORDINANCE 06-2014-01: Seth Weaver made a motion to approve the Special Election Ordinance. Lynn Adams seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

PAVILLION ROOF BIDS: Two bids were received for the project of constructing a roof for the stage area at the gym park. The first bid was from Country Star Barns in the amount of \$9,237.00. The second bid was received from All Welding Services in the amount of \$13,200.00. John Brady made a motion to accept the bid from Country Star Barns in the amount of \$9,237.00. Kristi Crumpton seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed. The project should be completed before September 20, 2014.

COUNCIL MEMBER TIME:

Kristi Crumpton: Kristi announced the Farmers Market would possibly be relocating once the details are all worked out. The new location would be the lot to the right of Iron Accents. She said she thought this would provide more visibility to the public and the vendors would get more business.

Lynn Adams: Lynn asked the two coaches from White County whom she had recently spoke with about renting the ball field to come forward and explain to the Mayor and Council what they had in mind. After much discussion it was agreed upon they would use the field through December and would be responsible for all power bill charges concerning the concession stand and ball field lighting. If this works out then we would revisit the option for them to use again in January 2015.

Mayor Nix: Mayor Nix said the King Street Paving Project had been completed. The bill would be paid from SPLOST V, LMIG funds and the General fund.

Mayor Nix announced the Transportation Forum on Thursday, August 6th at 5:30pm to be held at the Government Center. He said everyone is welcome to attend and give their input.

He also said the next MPO meeting would be held in the Chattahoochee Center on Tuesday, August 12th.

The materials have been purchased for the electrical upgrade to be done at the Gym Park before Clermont Days. He said Home Depot kindly donated some of the supplies and said he would be lining up some workers to begin the project.

ADJOURN: Seth Weaver made a motion to adjourn at 7:05pm. Lynn Adams seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.
