

The Clermont Town Council met on December 2, 2014. The Mayor called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Seth Weaver gave the invocation and Mayor Nix led the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Mayor, James Nix, Council members, Kristi Crumpton, Seth Weaver, and, Eric Thomas. Deputy Clerk, Amy Lomax and Town Clerk, Sandra Helton.

MINUTES: Seth Weaver made a motion to approve the November 2014 Minutes. Eric Thomas seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: Seth Weaver made a motion to approve the October 2014 Financial Statement. Kristi Crumpton seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

REPORT: ORDINANCE 97-01 PLANNING AND ZONING: The council reviewed this report.

SECOND READING OF MILLAGE ORDINANCE 2014-11-01: AN ORDINANCE TO FIX THE AD VALOREM TAX RATE FOR THE TOWN OF CLERMONT FOR THE CALENDAR YEAR 2014 AND FOR USE IN THE FISCAL YEAR OF 2014—2015; The gross millage rate is set at 4.4 mills on each \$1,000.00 of taxable property and is hereby reduced by a roll back of 4.4 mills and therefore the net millage rate of 0.00 mills for the fiscal year 2014-2015. Seth Weaver made a motion to approve Ordinance 2014-11-01. Kristi Crumpton seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

SIGN AT KING STREET: The Mayor and Council agreed to table this item due to John Brady being absent.

LMIG PROJECT: Seth Weaver made a motion to officially submit the resurfacing of King Street as our upcoming 2015 LMIG Project. Eric Thomas seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor.

SPLOST VII: Eric Thomas made a motion to accept the draft project of the 2015 SPLOST VII referendum. (\$150K roads, streets and sidewalks, \$150K parks, \$350K buildings.) Kristi Crumpton seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed. The Mayor mentioned the SPLOST VII meeting on Monday for anyone wishing to attend.

CHRISTMAS BONUS: Seth Weaver made a motion to give a Christmas bonus in the amount of \$100.00 to Town Clerk, Sandra Helton, Deputy Clerk, Amy Lomax, Maintenance Supervisor, Tommy Rogers, and Maintenance worker, Jason Greenway. Kristi Crumpton seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

Mayor: Mayor Nix mentioned that he had received an email from Attorney Syfan regarding coin operated machines. The Town of Clermont currently does not have an ordinance on this

matter. Georgia Municipal Association has a sample ordinance that is available. Council member Eric Thomas suggested we discuss it in the next work session. Everyone agreed.
