

The Clermont Town Council met on June 25, 2015 for a special called meeting. The Mayor called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Seth Weaver gave the invocation and Mayor Nix led the Pledge of Allegiance. Present: Mayor, James Nix, Council members, Kristi Crumpton, John Brady, and Seth Weaver. Deputy Clerk, Amy Lomax, and Town Clerk, Sandra Helton.

2015-2016 BUDGET: The 2015-2016 budget is set for \$320,500.00 John Brady made a motion to adopt the 2015-2016 budget. Seth Weaver seconded, and all council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

SECOND READING OF ORDINANCE 82-2015-06-01: TO REGULATE THE SALE, USE, EXPLOSION OF, POSSESSION, MANUFACTURE, TRANSPORT OR THE STORAGE OF ANY CONSUMER FIREWORKS OR FIREWORKS TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY THE GENERAL LAW OF THE STATE OF GEORGIA;

After the second reading was read by Mayor Nix, Seth Weaver made a motion to accept the second reading and approve Ordinance 82-2015-06-01. Kristi Crumpton seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed

BRENT FUTO-DISCHARGE OF WEAPONS: Council member John Brady said he spoke with some of the neighbors. They said they were not in favor of discharging his weapons even if it was only one hour a month as he is requesting. Kristi Crumpton stated it was located near a horse barn. After some discussion, Seth Weaver and Kristi Crumpton agreed to go out to the property and decide if the area and surrounding areas were safe to fire weapons. Seth Weaver made a motion to table this item until the next council meeting. John Brady seconded, and all council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

PARK ORDINANCE 99-03 REVISION APPROVAL: Kristi Crumpton stated we need to finalize the changes being made to the current park ordinance. The changes being made will be changing the name from Clermont Gym Park to Chattahoochee Park and the baseball field hours being changed from 1:00pm to 10:00pm on Sundays. Also being added to the ordinance is no smoking. The ordinance is to be sent to attorney David Syfan to finalize it.

CHARGES FOR CCC-NORTH HALL DRAMA DEPARTMENT: Kristi Crumpton said she had been contacted by the drama departments for North Hall High School, North Hall Middle School and Mt. Vernon Elementary seeking permission to use the Chattahoochee Center during the construction of their new theatre. After some discussion of how much to charge each drama department it was agreed to charge the drama departments these amounts. North Hall High School-\$500.00, North Hall Middle School-\$175.00, and Mt. Vernon Elementary -\$100.00. John Brady made a motion to accept the fees set forth by the Mayor and Council. Seth Weaver seconded, and all council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

COUNCIL MEMBER TIME:

JOHN BRADY: John Brady presented a quote in the amount \$2,265.84 for a counters to be constructed in the town hall to allow for more room in the office. The Mayor and Council agreed

to look into removing the wall between the office and outer area and constructing one closer to the entrance door.

MAYOR NIX: Mayor Nix said he had talked to Greg Forrester about a new metal roof with gable ends for the new park bathroom. The cost would be \$4,800.00. He said our maintenance workers could put the insulation overhead. Mayor Nix said he had picked up the windows that were ordered for the new bathroom and also that Chattahoochee Doors in Cornelia was coming to install the new doors. Everyone agreed to move forward with this next step of the construction of the bathroom.

Mayor Nix also reminded everyone of the open-house at Glo-Crest Dairy Farm from 11-2pm on Friday June 26, 2015.

ADJOURN: John Brady made a motion to adjourn at 8:26pm. Kristi Crumpton seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.
