

The Clermont Town Council met on February 6, 2018. The Mayor called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Present: Mayor, James Nix, Council Members, Doug Myers, Seth Weaver, Marcia Kesler, and James Castleberry. Town Clerk, Sandra Helton and Deputy Clerk, Amy Lomax.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Seth Weaver made a motion to approve the agenda. James Castleberry seconded, and all council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Seth Weaver led the invocation and Mayor Nix led the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES- JANUARY 2018: Seth Weaver made a motion to accept the January 2018 Minutes. Marcia Kesler seconded, and all Council members voted in favor. Motion passed.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: The Mayor and Council reviewed the December 2017 Financial Report.

REPORT: ORDINANCE 97-01 PLANNING AND ZONING: The Mayor and Council reviewed this report.

SECOND READING OF ORDINANCE 2018-01-01 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE 2018 SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE TOWN OF CLERMONT, GEORGIA: This is an election to fill the seat in Ward 1 previously held by Robin Brown who resigned in December 2017. Mayor Nix gave the second reading of Ordinance 2018-01-01: An Ordinance providing for the 2018 Special Election for the Town of Clermont, Georgia. Seth Weaver made a motion to approve the final reading of Ordinance 2018-01-01. James Castleberry seconded, and all council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

MEMORIAL SERVICE FOR THE 1998 TORNADO VICTIMS: There will be a memorial service held at the Clay E. Gailey Park on March 17th at 10:00am. This is the 20th year anniversary of the 1998 tornado and this will be a memorial service in remembrance of the victims. Seth Weaver said he was finishing up some details and ask if the Council had anything they would like to add or change. Mayor Nix said the biggest challenge would be getting in touch with the families of these victims. Everyone is invited to attend.
