

The Clermont Town Council met on March 6, 2018. The Mayor called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm. Present: Mayor, James Nix, Council Members, Doug Myers, Seth Weaver, Marcia Kesler, and James Castleberry. Town Clerk, Sandra Helton and Deputy Clerk, Amy Lomax.

APPROVAL OF AGENDA: Seth Weaver made a motion to approve the agenda. Doug Myers seconded, and all council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Seth Weaver led the invocation and Mayor Nix led the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES- FEBRUARY 2018: Seth Weaver made a motion to accept the February 2018 Minutes. Marcia Kesler seconded, and all Council members voted in favor. Motion passed.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: The Mayor and Council reviewed the January 2018 Financial Report.

REPORT: ORDINANCE 97-01 PLANNING AND ZONING: The Mayor and Council reviewed this report.


LIONS' CLUB FUNDRAISER: Danny Head approached the Mayor and Council on behalf of the Lion's Club to announce a fundraiser planned for Saturday, June 2, 2018. The Mayor and Council agreed to allow them to use the building for \$150.00 for four hours and this would include the kitchen. Everyone is invited to attend and the tickets are \$10.00.

TORNADO VICTIMS MEMORIAL SERVICE: Seth Weaver announced he was wrapping up some last-minute details for the memorial service. The memorial service will be held on March 17th at 10:00 am. He encouraged everywhere to attend.

CLEAN-UP ISSUES IN DOWNTOWN CLERMONT: James Castleberry said some citizens had approached him about the maintenance of the yards in Clermont. There are some places in Town that obviously are requiring some attention. He read the Town's ordinances and was wanting clarification on how the Town handles these types of situations. After some discussion, the Mayor explained a letter is usually the first attempt in trying to resolve these issues.

After some discussion about buying a trailer to store the equipment, they agreed to wait and purchase review options for storing the equipment. The Mayor and Council all voted in favor. Motion passed.
