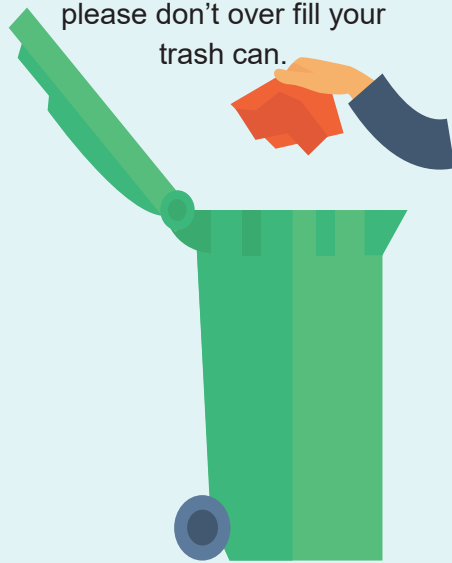


Trash Pick Up

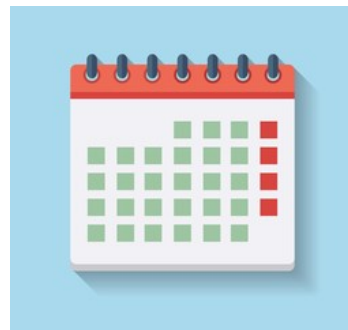

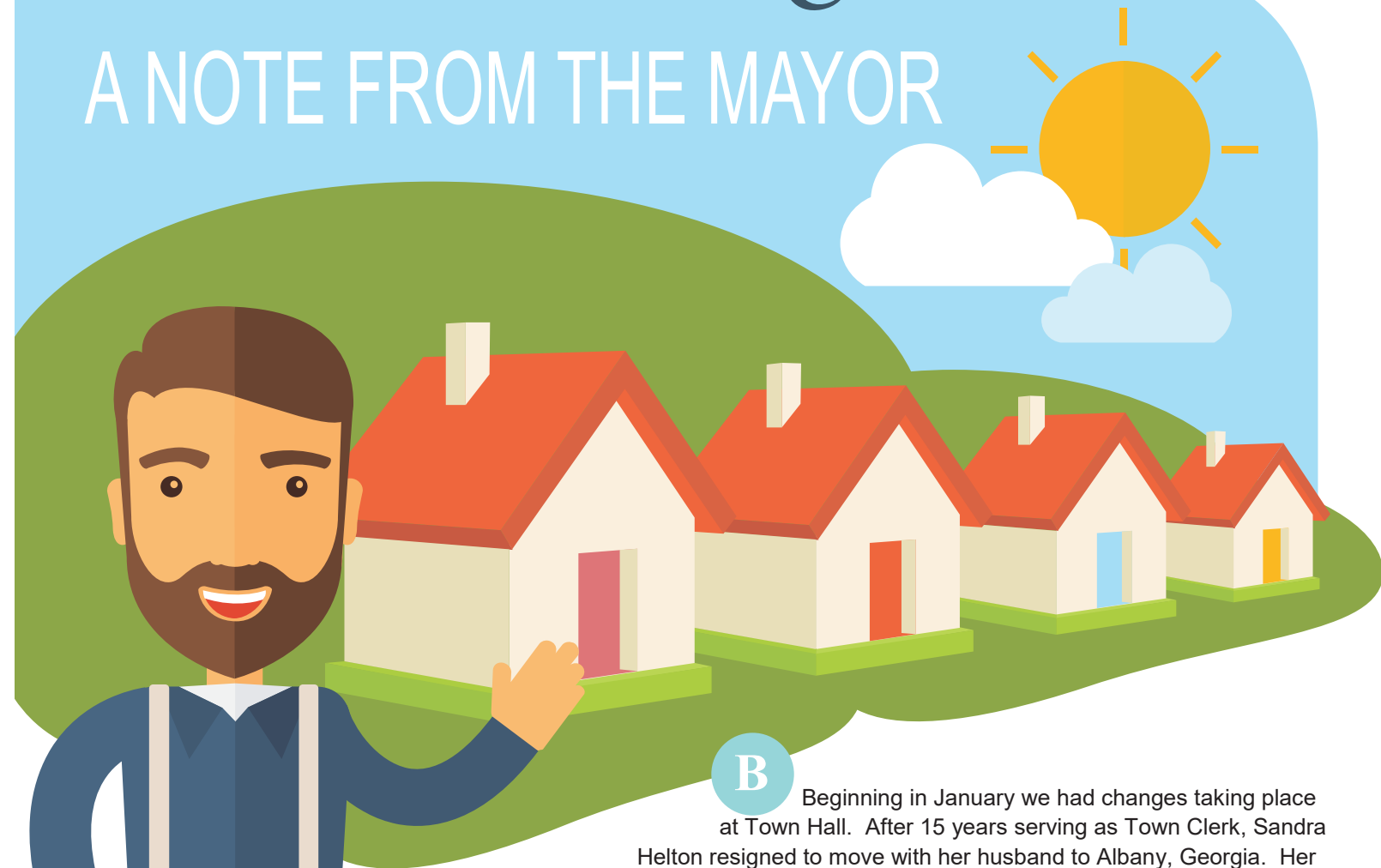

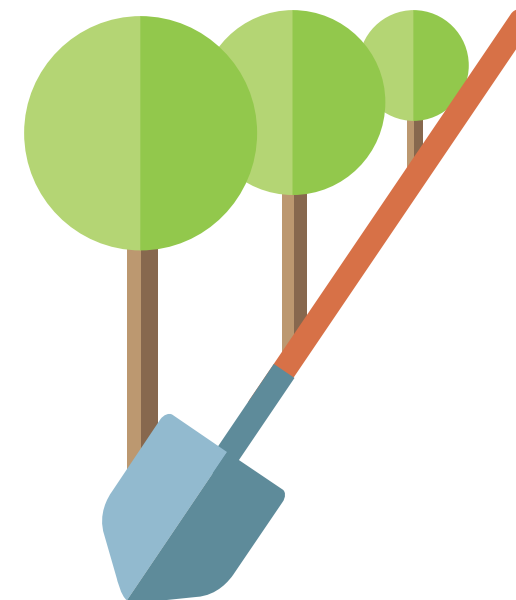
