

Town of Clermont
Town Council Meeting
August 1, 2023

The Clermont Town Council met on August 1, 2023. The Mayor called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present: Mayor James Nix, Council Members Doug Myers, James Castleberry, Marcia Kesler, Seth Weaver, and Council Member Amanda Nix joined by telephone. Town Clerk Amy Lomax also attended.

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA: Doug Myers motioned to approve the agenda. James Castleberry seconded, and all Council members voted in favor. Motion passed.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: Council Member James Castleberry led the invocation, and Mayor Nix led the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES-July 2023: Doug Myers motioned to accept the July 2023 Minutes. James Castleberry seconded the motion, and all Council members voted in favor. Motion passed.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: The Mayor and Council reviewed the June 2023 Financial Report.

REPORT: PLANNING AND ZONING: The Mayor and Council reviewed this report.

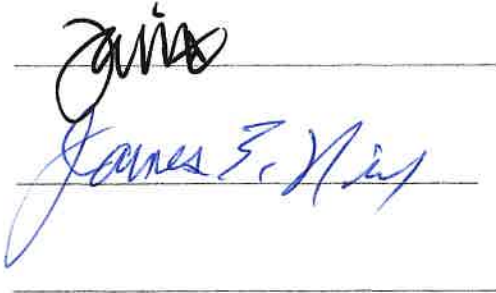
SECOND READING OF ORDINANCE: 82-2023-07-06- Mayor Nix gave the second reading of the Ordinance. This is an ordinance to fix the ad valorem tax rate for the Town of Clermont for the calendar year 2023 and use in the fiscal year of 2023-2024; to levy said tax upon all property subject to taxation by the Town of Clermont; to provide for the time of payment of said taxes; to repeal conflicting ordinances and for other purposes. Seth Weaver motioned to approve the Ordinance, Doug Myers seconded the motion, and all Council members voted in favor. Motion passed.

CLERMONT DAYS 2023: Amy Lomax gave an update on the upcoming Clermont Days Festival in September. The planning is going well; we have over one hundred vendors this year.

MARKET STREET PARK: Amy Lomax informed the Council that the quote for the playground surfacing has increased to \$98,938.78. The previous quote was \$94,425.00. The price increase is due to the increase in the foam and different thicknesses needed to be installed to achieve your critical fall height ratings for the equipment we are getting. Seth Weaver made a motion to approve the updated quote of \$98,938.78. Doug Myers seconded the motion, and all Council members voted in favor.

ADJOURN: Seth Weaver made a motion to adjourn at 7:18 p.m. Doug Myers seconded the motion, and all Council members voted in favor. Motion passed.
