Town Council Meeting
February 5, 2026

The Clermont Town Council met on February 5, 2026. The Mayor called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. Present were Mayor James Nix, Council Members Marcia Kesler, James Castleberry, Amanda Nix, and John Brady. Town Clerk Amy Lomax also attended.

APPROVAL OF THE AGENDA: John Brady motioned to approve the agenda. Amanda Nix seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. The motion passed.

INVOCATION AND PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE: James Castleberry led the invocation, and Mayor Nix led the Pledge of Allegiance.

MINUTES - JANUARY 2026: John Brady motioned to approve the January 2026 Minutes. Marcia Kesler seconded the motion, and all Council members present voted in favor. The motion passed.

FINANCIAL STATEMENT: The Mayor and Council reviewed the December 2025 Financial Report.

REPORT: PLANNING AND ZONING: The Mayor and Council reviewed this report.

PROJECT UPDATES:

Mayor James Nix gave an update on the Veterans Park project. The Chattahoochee Group has begun the site work. We are still looking for sponsors. We have received around \$30,000.00 in donations/sponsorship to date. We have around 41 brick orders in as well, and two of the benches have been sponsored. Depending on the weather, the Veterans Park could be completed in April.

Amy Lomax gave the Council an update on the Community Center renovation and new carpet for the Chattahoochee Center. We have received three carpet quotes. We are waiting on samples from one of the companies, and once we receive them, we should be able to move forward with scheduling and the installation date. She also gave an update on the planned celebration for the Americas' 250th anniversary. We have the fireworks and entertainment scheduled for July 3, 2026. A cruise-in is also scheduled in conjunction with the celebration.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: The Mayor invited public comments. There were no public comments.
