Town of Clermont Work Session Meeting May 17, 2022

The Clermont Town Council met on May 17, 2022, for a work session and public hearing for the FY 2023 budget. Present: Mayor, James Nix, Council members, Amanda Nix, Doug Myers, James Castleberry, and Marcia Kesler. Town Clerk, Amy Lomax, and Assistant Town Clerk, Robin Bryson also attended.

PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE 2022-2023 TOWN OF CLERMONT BUDGET: Mayor Nix opened the public hearing on the proposed budget at 7:00 pm. The proposed budget is \$484,350.00. He asked for any comments or questions. There was one comment from the audience asking for a more detailed breakdown of the budget. He was given the budget worksheet that is used to help determine the budget category numbers. No further comments or questions were raised at this time.

KING STREET PARKING LOT QUOTE: The Council was given a quote for \$2952.50 from Stripe-It-Right Inc. to seal and re-stripe the parking lot at Town Hall and Market Street Park. Doug Myers made a motion to accept the quote. James Castleberry seconded, and all Council members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

PARK SIGNS: The Council agreed to place signs at the parks prohibiting unauthorized ATVs, or motorcycles on Town property.

PERDUE HOUSE: Council Member, James Castleberry informed the Council that he was contacted by someone about the Town possibly acquiring the Perdue House located on Concord Baptist Campus and having it moved to Town property. He has been in contact with someone from the Church and at this time they have not made a final decision on what they will be doing in the future with the house.

COUNCIL UPDATES: Council Member, Amanda Nix gave the Council a quote she received from Georgia Power on placing additional lighting at the Chattahoochee Park. The Council decided that only one additional light at the park pointing toward the playground area would be beneficial. Amanda is going to contact the representative from Georgia Power to get an updated quote on the installation of one additional light. Amanda also informed the Council that the proceeds from the Town yard sale totaled \$1086.00. The proceeds will go toward park equipment.

PUBLIC HEARING FOR THE 2022-2023 TOWN OF CLERMONT BUDGET: With there being no further comments from the audience or the Council on the proposed budget, the public hearing was closed at 8:08. The Council will hold the second public hearing and the vote for the budget at the June 7, 2022, Council Meeting.
