REPORT: PLANNING AND ZONING: The Mayor and Council reviewed this report.

BALLFIELD LEASE: Marcia Kesler motioned to increase the annual lease amount to \$3200.00 for the North Hall Jr. Trojan's use of the baseball field. Doug Myers seconded the motion, and all Council Members present voted in favor. Motion passed.

The Council approved renewing the yearly agreement with the North Hall Jr. Trojans for the use of the baseball field and with Next Level Sports for the use of the softball fields.

PROJECT UPDATES: The Town Clerk updated the Council on the progress of the Market Street Playground. The existing playground equipment was listed and auctioned off on Gov. Deals. It is scheduled to be removed on Friday, September 8, 2023. The New Playground is scheduled to be installed around the middle of October. We received great feedback from the Community when we put a notice on social media informing the Community about the construction timeline for the playground installation. Council Member Seth Weaver asked which SPLOST Fund we will use to pay for the equipment and installation. The mayor told him SPLOST VIII.

PUBLIC COMMENTS: The Mayor asked the audience if anyone had anything they would like to say. With no comments, the Mayor called for the meeting to be adjourned.
